Detective Loren Erdman provided the following:

- Cunningham had been in the "Family" for close to five years. The "Family" is drug oriented. They follow the Phil Lesh Band and sell drugs at the concerts, also at Rainbow gatherings, Hemp Fests and Barter Faires.
- O'Ryan used to run the Portland Family until he was arrested about three and one-half years ago. At that time Rob Schultz and "Shadow" took over the "Family" in Portland.
- Family in San Francisco, Los Angeles and Seattle would have to agree for Rob Schultz to be the Portland boss. Rob Schultz asked Cunningham to go to Stevens County, Crown Creek area, to grow marijuana and find a supplier for cheap marijuana for the Portland Family. Cunningham knew that John Grange "Chuey" worked for Schultz for approximately two years selling pot, acting as bodyguard, and collecting. The "Family" taught Kaiser to make LSD with the chemicals coming from California.
- Cunningham said Schultz and "Shadow" wanted John Grange "Chuey" to go to the cabin at Crow Creek because Cunningham wasn't doing what they wanted. Cunningham was tired of the "Family" telling him what to do but not paying him. "Chuey" was supposed to make a bigger or better "family" influence in Northport and gain respect for the family.

- Schultz had mentioned to "Chuey" that they needed a lawyer in the "Family" and said they might put him through law school.
- Cunningham said "Chuey" had Family members under him who sold drugs for him.
- The purchase and possession of a semi-automatic .22 caliber rifle on June 7, 2000, two days before the Northport Barter Faire was to begin and four days before it was used to kill Nick Kaiser and Josh Schaefer.
- A large tattoo on the defendant's back about the "Irish Mafia".
